

Field Conveyor Belt Technician

The field conveyor belt technician position will participate in the installation of light to heavy weight conveyor belting, performing mechanical or vulcanized splices for industrial and mining customers. Must have the ability to perform conveyor related services including but not limited to changing idlers, pulleys, bearings, belt cleaners, guarding, chutes, hoods, and other mechanical services as needed in the field or shop settings.

Responsibilities:

- Field installation/ servicing/ mechanical and vulcanized splicing of light and heavy weight conveyor belt. (Technical training will be provided)
- Fulfill shop orders for light and heavy weight conveyor belt including slit to width, cut to length, splice preparation, installation of cleats and banner edges. (Technical training will be provided).
- Unloading, receiving and stocking of incoming shipments. Palletizing, boxing and loading
 of outbound shipments via UPS and truck. General warehouse organization and upkeep.
- Local deliveries and pick-ups in company pick-up truck. No special license classification necessary.
- Load the truck and make deliveries of conveyor belting and conveyor components in the assigned region, per customer requirements.
- Warehouse work to include driving a forklift, stocking and pulling material and cutting and lacing belts. Training will be provided for belting work.
- Must have mechanical aptitude, with the ability to learn new processes and equipment quickly.
- Must have the ability to adhere to all company Safety Standards.
- Must have the ability to be work non-standard business hours as needed, and travel for up to 10 days at a time on short notice.
- Must be punctual and professional at all times.

Education and Experience:

- High school diploma or equivalent. Associates degree in a mechanical field preferable but not required.
- At least one year of experience in welding, automotive or diesel repair, heavy equipment, electrical, or hydraulics preferred but not required.
